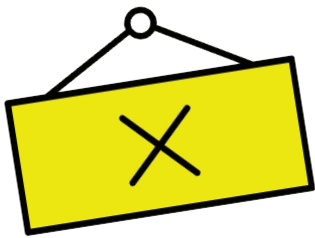
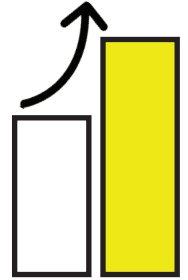


# THE HIGH CO\$T OF VOTER ID in **JOHNSTON COUNTY**

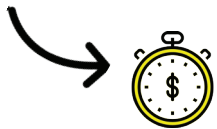
Recent analysis\* of the proposed Voter Restriction Amendment, requiring photo identification to vote, reveals the proposal's high financial and human costs to Johnston County.

In 2015, African-American voters made up **16%** of registered voters in Johnston County, but **31%** of registered voters without photo ID.

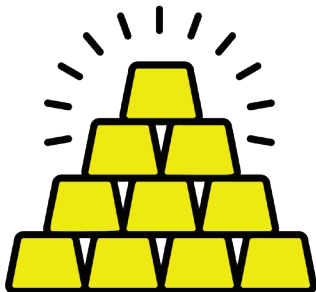


Johnston County had 6 early voting sites in 2014 and 2016. Thanks to a new law, there are only **3 early voting sites** this year.

The average cost for a voter in Johnston County to get a photo ID is **\$121 to \$150**.



That translates to **7.9-9.8** hours of work for a median wage employee in the county.



The estimated total cost for voters in Johnston County to acquire photo ID is between **\$270k-\$335k**.
