STATE JUDGES AND JUSTICES: N.C. COURT OF APPEALS AND SUPREME COURT

The state's highest courts hold the governor and legislature accountable. They make big decisions on issues from redistricting to death penalty appeals. They are the final word on what is "constitutional" and other interpretations of state laws.

STATE LEGISLATURE: N.C. SENATE AND N.C. HOUSE

The two chambers of the N.C. General Assembly hold the power to draft state laws on anything they choose. They can address criminal justice issues, draw our voting maps, and decide the future of healthcare access in our state. They also use our taxpayer dollars to set the state budget, including resources for everything from roads to schools.

CONGRESS: U.S. SENATE AND U.S. HOUSE

With the ability to make U.S. law and oversee federal agencies, Congress' powers include spending our tax dollars, enacting gun legislation, taking the country to war, deciding who gets healthcare and environmental protections, and when to hold the President accountable — from appointments to impeachments.
